Contract Title: Rehabilitation of Expressway No.1 – Part of Section R9A – Additional works from Sta 40+000 to Sta. 51+000 Tharthar Intersection

The Government of Iraq (GoI) represented by the Ministry of Construction and Housing and Public Municipalities (MoCHPM)/ Roads and Bridges Directorate (RBD) has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Transport Corridors Project (TCP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Rehabilitation of Expressway No.1 – Part of Section R9A Additional works from Sta. 40+000 to Sta. 51+000 Tharthar Intersection.

The (MoCHPM)/ (RBD) now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for rehabilitation works of R9A, starting at Sta. km 40+000 km to 50+000 km. approximate length (10) km. The scope of work consists of the rehabilitation of the existing expressway and it includes but not limited to: (i) Milling 4cm of the existing deteriorated pavement where rutting and high-intensity cracks are present and stockpiling of the milled material within the ROW and repaving the milled section with 4cm with the non-polymerized wearing course; (ii) Paving the whole section under rehabilitation with 5cm polymerized Asphalt (PG) leveling course layer; (iii) Culverts repairs, Repair, and improvement of traffic safety measures (steel guardrail, traffic signs, pavement marking, road furniture and Chain-link (fencing); (iv) Parking areas rehabilitation; (v) Implementation of the environmental and social monitoring plan (ESMP); (vi) Preparation and implementation of Traffic Management Plan (TMP) as per the Traffic Management Plan that will be prepared by the contractor and approved by the Engineer and PMT, including all traffic safety measures and devices with special attention made to the case where opposing traffic is using the same carriageway; and (vii) Implementation of the Occupational Hazard and Safety (OHS) measures.

Bidding will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's [Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, dated January 2011](#) ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
